

Community Hosts

Freedom Keepers United is in search of community hosts that possess strong leadership skills and are highly dependable. As community hosts your sole role within the organization will be to grow local communities and ensure they become self-sustainable, offering a valuable resource that individuals and families can rely on long term. Community hosts will be responsible for hosting in person events and providing a reliable community resource to their local Freedom Keepers' chapters and community. The ideal candidate has flexible availability, a dependable schedule, and strong community event planning and management skills. The ultimate goal of a community host is to build a strong network of empowered advocates who can educate and empower their local community together while creating sustainable solutions that fit their local community needs.

Community Host Responsibilities:

- **General**
 - Building, maintaining, and stoking valuable relationships with community members, developing a healthy and positive community culture.
 - Keeping community members updated on the latest organization updates in order to prepare them for upcoming events and actions.
 - Encouraging advocacy action and providing opportunities for education.
 - Understanding clearly the needs of your community and providing opportunities to create solutions as a group.
 - Community hosts are responsible for representing the core values and mission of Freedom Keepers United; he or she must not misrepresent FKU in any way. The host must not quarrel, argue, or engage in any volatile, aggressive, or violent behavior with event guests. Violation of this policy will result in disciplinary action dependent on the magnitude of the situation.
- **Social Media and Communication**
 - Becoming a social media moderator on our new community platform
 - Creating and modifying upcoming events for your local community and ensuring the accurate and up to date information is posted in the community forum.
 - Sending event updates to all individuals who have registered for a specific event.
 - Driving traffic to your local chapter's group on the community platform and optimizing membership conversions.
 - Alerting your chapter and potential members about upcoming events via social platforms.
 - Moderating content and conversations within your community group to ensure a safe and positive environment for all who participate.
- **Hosting Events:**
 - Provide a series of consistent events at which local Freedom Keepers can attend and connect with each other.
 - Foster a team of at least 2 other community hosts who can help manage the series of events you have planned.

- Ensure a co-host or sub-host, who is also a community host or a similarly knowledgeable volunteer, has been found to take your place in the event you cannot host your own event. This person must be familiar with our general guidelines and standards.
- Create a positive atmosphere amongst Freedom Keepers who attend through effective communication of group rules, expectations and guidelines.
- Provide opportunities for feedback, independent pod growth, education, workshops, and long term solutions to childcare, education, and co-ops.

Community Hosts Requirements:

- Must be dependable and have flexible availability
- Must have excellent written, verbal and interpersonal communication skills.
- Must have strong leadership skills that influence positive growth.
- Must have experience building community relationships and encouraging positive group culture.
- Must have the ability to maintain a positive attitude focused on mission oriented growth and development.
- Must be highly organized and solution oriented
